ACRC FUNDRAISER

If you have missed the last few monthly meetings, you may not be aware of the fact that our paved runway will need replacement. It's not to the point of immediate replacement, but it will need to be replaced within the next five years. While this gives us a window of time for planning purposes, it also gives us time to raise the necessary funds. Today's price on asphalt replacement is in the neighborhood of \$1.75 square per Considering that we have roughly 10,000 square feet of runway, that's a high priced neighborhood. Short of winning the lottery, we need to raise the money ourselves. Continued on Next Page I've looked at several fun raising programs, and I found one presented by the Minnesota Fresh Water Society (MnFWS). They are the makers of the Minnesota Weather Guide calendars.

MnFWS offer three types of fundraising programs. The one we have chosen at this time is a consignment program, meaning they give us the calendars to sell, at the end of a block of time, we return the unsold calendars, and pay for those we have sold. The caveat to this is the returned calendars must be in salable condition. We cannot return a calendar that looks like it came out of the bottom of a birdcage.

Now is the time for "revenge" on those folks who have hit you up for magazine subscriptions, wrapping paper, and Girl Scout cookies. The calendars also make nice Christmas gifts, for you to give, or to suggest an "up sell" to prospective customers.

I will have the calendars at the club meetings, so let's give this a try and raise some funds for the runway.
